

# Zebra V2.3 ReadMe

Thanks for demoing/upgrading to Zebra V2.3 – it's a great software synthesizer. But before you start, please read these lines to ensure the best user experience!

## Before you install

If you already have an older version of Zebra 2.x installed it is recommended to backup your patches so nothing gets lost by accident.

Updating on Windows: If you chose „Everything in Vstplugins“ in previous installers, you may rather download & install the „pre-installed“ version of Zebra2. There's an easy way to find out: If you have a directory called „Zebra2.data“ in Vstplugins then you need the pre-installed version. Otherwise you should use the installer.

Updating on MacOS X: If you have older versions of Zebra installed in your home Library location, you should move these to the trash before you install. That especially accounts for VST versions in MacHD/Users/You/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST/

## Installation

On MacOS X or using the Windows installer, just doubleclick the installer and follow the instructions.

If you have the pre-installed version for Windows, just copy the .dll files and the „Zebra2.data“ directory to Vstplugins. Be cautious though – **if you overwrite an older „Zebra2.data“ directory, files may get lost.** In that case you may want to backup „Presets“ and „Support“ (for your preferences and registration info).

## What's new in V2.3?

- RTAS support on MacOS X
- switchable & scalable user interface themes
- additions to oscillators („Eleven“, more Osc FX)
- LFO speeds can now be set independent from host tempo
- MIDI Program Changes
- several bugfixes, including MidiLearn woes
- new Sideband Filter (frequency shifter) modules
- new ModMapper modules
- FX Bypass
- Voice Drift can now be switched off for strict tuning
- improved host compatibility/workarounds incl. „Logic reset“ and „Live no-reset“
